Current Party: Conservatives (majority 6,000, 75% turnout, 2019)

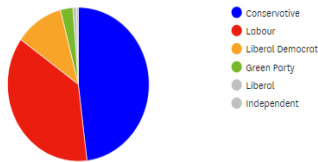
Current MP: Graham Brady is the chair of the 1920 Committee and member of the CFI, he is stepping -down this election.
