Current Party: Labour (majority 14,000, 54% turnout, 2019)

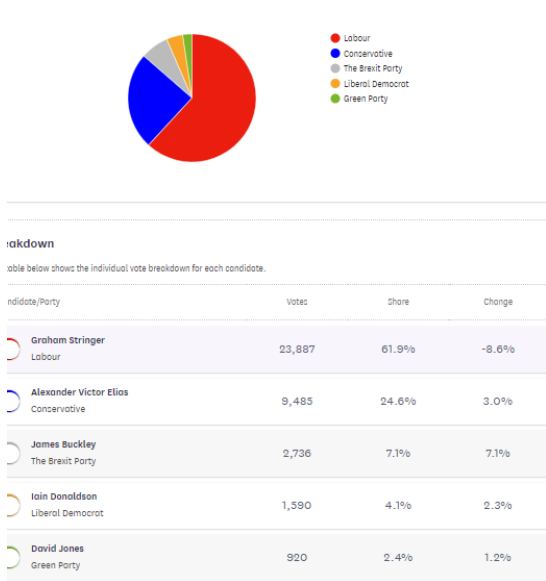
Current MP: Graham Stringer is member of the CFI and climate change denial.

Voting Objective – Tactical

We endorse the Green candidate Dylan Lewis-Creser.

- Reasoning Blackley and Broughton is Labour strong hold, with significant majority, Muslim vote is strong and could disrupt Labour control of this key seat.
- Recommendation is through eliminating Labour, Conservatives and Reform
- In October 2023, the Party issued a call for an immediate ceasefire, for the provision of immediate humanitarian aid, and for or a just political settlement based on the end of occupation of the Palestinian territories.
- Green likely to gain more votes, Dylan local councillor and supports a ceasefire call.
