

Shows the recent election history for Bolton North East.



GMMV Recommendation

We endorse the Green party candidate, Hanif Ali because:

- Labour is expected to win but our aim is to substantially reduce Labour's predicted majority. The Green candidate is currently predicted to come 4th
- With support of the Muslim electorate, the Green party could become second ahead of Conservative and Reform, which would be a major success for Muslims and would send a strong message to the major parties.
- 3. In October 2023, the Party issued a call for an immediate ceasefire, for the provision of immediate humanitarian aid, and for or a just political settlement based on the end of occupation of the Palestinian territories.
- 4. Hanif Ali, in his first local election secured a comprehensive victory, becoming the first Green Councillor in Bolton. So has a good platform on which to build.
- 5. He has re-posted in support of Palestine on his LinkedIn account.
- 6. The WPB Muslim candidate, Syeda Kazmi is a councillor in Burnley, so she no existing local voter base and is currently predicting at less than 1% support.
