Voting Objective - Protest Vote

We endorse the Workers Party of Britain candidate **Shafat Ali**, because:

- The objective is to demonstrate to both main parties the support withdrawn by local Muslims. Muslim Vote unlikely to determine outcome.
- Labour is overwhelmingly predicted to win, with Conservative coming second.
- Though Independent candidate Anwarul Haq is local with stronger links to local Muslim community, he is unlikely to gain wider support across constituency and no evidence of community backed campaign beyond himself.
- Workers Party candidate Shafat Ali appears to have a community supported campaign.
- Workers Party also fared quite well at recent Local Elections in 2 of the council wards with significant Muslim population
