

GMMV Recommendation

We recommend the Lib Dem candidate, Richard Kilpatrick because:

- Jeff Smith, a member of the Labour Friends of Israel (LFI) did not vote for a ceasefire 15th of November 2023. He also failed to sign an Early Day Motion that calls for the end to the siege on Gaza and allow AID into the Gaza Strip. He, also failed to sign a motion to suspend UK arms export licences to Israel and failed to sign the motion supporting the ICJ ruling.
- 2. The LibDem party has consistently called for a Ceasefire in Gaza
- 3. Richard Kilpatrick has responded positively to our pledge's questionnaire.
- 4. He has a long history of standing in elections and is currently the Councillor of Didsbury West, so has some electoral backing.
- 5. Manchester Withington is predominantly a twohorse race between Lib Dem and Labour.
- 6. If the Muslim electorate vote for someone other than the Lib Dem candidate, then this could result in Labour retaining the seat.
