Current Party: Labour (majority 6,700, 54% turnout 59%, 2022 By-elections)

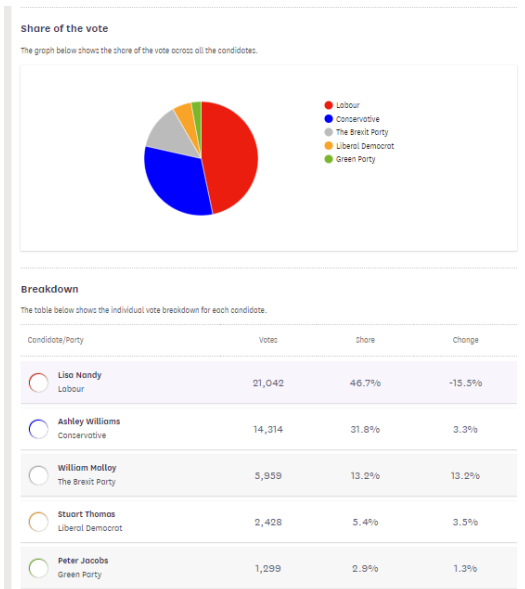
Current MP: Lisa Nandi
