Current Party: Labour (majority 3,000, 59% turnout)

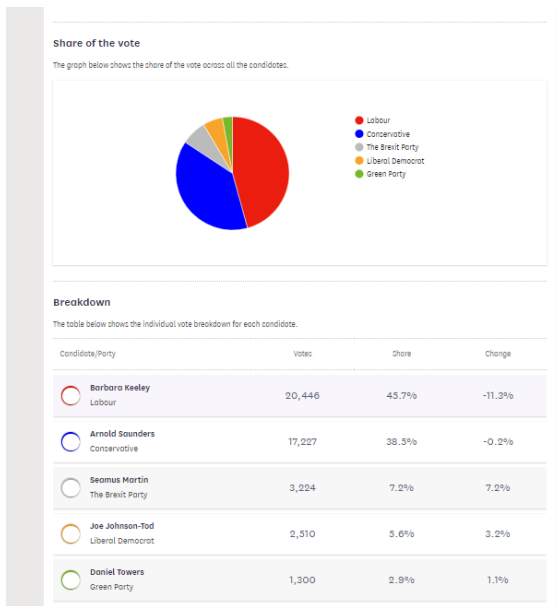
Current MP: Barbara Kealy, is stepping down in this election to a new Labour candidate
