Current Party: Labour (majority 10,000, 58% turnout)

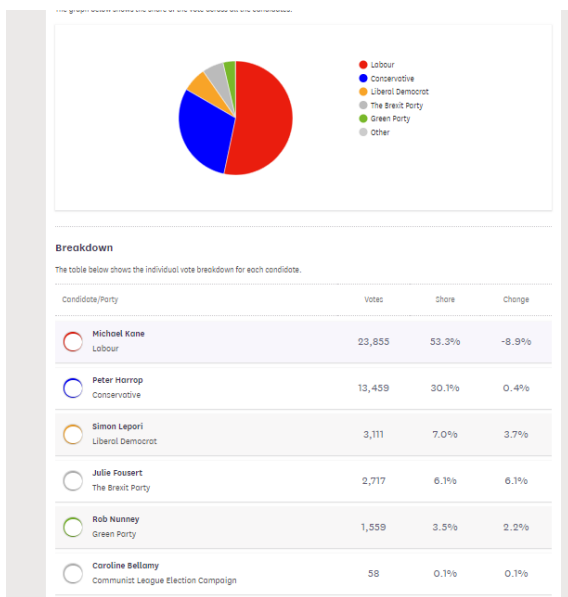
Current MP: Mike Kane, Previously, he was Shadow Minister for International Development from September 2015 to October 2016
